**DIRECTOR OF SPORT DEVELOPMENT**

The Director of Sport Development will be responsible for planning and organizing sports projects and campaigns aligned with the provincial needs in order to get more people involved by working towards making the sport of handball more accessible to everyone. The director ensure that people have the chance to take part in the sport of Team Handball and ensure that all sections of the general community are aware of available activities and where they can go to get involved. The Sport Development Director will distribute information and organize team handball-related projects and programs to attend the needs of the sport growth connected with the provincial federations. The development of coaching – NCCP implementation to form new coaches and the referee development program are also part of Director of Sport Development duties.

**GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Maintain close contact with the Provincial Federations to better address the needs of the sport development;
- Develop, organize, and/or coordinate handball programs to assist provinces in promoting the growth of the sport;
- Responsible for monitoring the Sport Development programs and assess their progress;
- Liaising and working with relevant organizations or agencies including youth services, school boards, clubs, sports coaches associations and sports councils;
- Raise public awareness about team handball and promote participation in the sport; • Work with National and Local Partners to promote handball in different communities in partnership with the provincial federations;
- Coordinate with NACHC developments commissions;
- Coordinate with Sport Canada and Centre for Ethics on requirements and program changes;
- Coordinate with Coaches Association of Canada NCCP development and program changes;

- Coordinate with Canadian Head of Officials along with regional leaders, on official and delegate development.
